- **Be Comfortable Not Knowing:** Accept that clarity comes with time, not immediately.
- **Stay Open to Discovery:** Let customer insights and lived experiences shape the direction, rather than sticking rigidly to assumptions or plans.
- Value the Process, Not just the Outcome: Trust that learning and iteration are part of getting to the right solution.
- Hold Space for Complexity: Understand that people's experiences aren't always neat or easy to categorize – and that's okay.

BENEFITS OF EMBRACING AMBIGUITY

- Encourages deeper exploration and richer insights
- Sparks creativity and innovation through flexibility
- Helps teams adapt to evolving information and feedback
- Builds resilience and comfort with complexity and change

HOW TO PRACTICE THIS MINDSET

- Ask Questions Without Needing Immediate Answers
 Use uncertainty as a tool for deeper inquiry and learning.

- Create Psychological Safety
 Support a team culture where it's okay to say, "We're still figuring it out."
